Classical Music Scholarship

This scholarship was initiated in 1981 by Donald and Enid Macardle, who were members of the Macardle Moore family, owners of the Dundalk Brewery. Louth County Council agreed to administer this award, which helps further the studies of successful applicants. The generosity of the Macardle family is much appreciated. The award shall consist of a grant to the winning competitor, of a sum not less than €1,000.

RULES OF ELIGIBILITY

- (a) *Applicants must be resident in County Louth.*
- (b) *Applicants must be pursuing studies in classical music and the scholarship must be applied to the furtherance of these studies.*
- (c) *Applicants must be between the ages of 12 and 16 years on January 31st, 2017. Birth certificates must be forwarded with this application form and will be returned at the earliest possible opportunity.*
- (d) *Applicants will be required to undergo a music audition. Applicants should bring their musical instruments and will be responsible for the expense of attending the audition. Applicants will be required to play for no more than 10 minutes. A piano is available for those wishing to audition on this instrument.*
- (e) *The adjudicator's decision will be final and no correspondence on this decision will be entered into. Any attempt to contact, or otherwise influence, the adjudicator will result in the disqualification of the applicant.*
- (f) *The award shall consist of a grant to the winning applicant, of a sum not less than €1,000.*
- (g) *All applications, irrespective of the address of the applicant within Louth, must be sent to - The Arts Office, Louth County Council, Town Hall, Crowe Street, Dundalk, County Louth.*
- (h) *Closing date for receipt of applications is 4.00pm, Thursday 30th March, 2017.*
