

Grants under the Arts Act, 2003



Louth County Council, through the Arts Service, operates a scheme for financially assisting arts activity in the county of Louth.

- There is no application form for this Scheme.
- Assistance will usually take the form of grant-in-aid. However, the provision of services or facilities by Louth County Council may be deemed more appropriate.
- Assistance will not be given in respect of events where it is envisaged that all or part of the proceeds will be donated to charity.
- Assistance will be given only in respect of specific future activities and not towards the payment of debts arising from previous events.
- Applicants must be over 18 years of age.
- Applications should be made in writing, and all applications, irrespective of the address of the applicant within Louth, must be sent to - The Arts Office, Louth County Council, Town Hall, Crowe Street, Dundalk, Co. Louth.

The following points must be included -

- (a) *A description of the proposed event or requirement.*
- (b) *A detailed income and expenditure account projecting figures as accurately as possible in respect of the project, and the total sought from Louth County Council*
- (c) *A declaration of grants and/or other assistance received or sought from any other source.*
- (d) *Any further particulars or information as the council may deem necessary to properly consider the application.*

Louth County Council must be credited in all publicity materials, publications, PR and or/media interviews and the CreateLouth logo included in any printed matter relating to the event or project.

Closing dates for receipt of application are 4.00pm, Thursday 30th March, 2017 and 4.00pm, Thursday 28th September, 2017.
