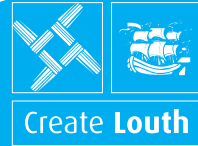


# Louth Local Authorities Young Music Awards

## RULES OF ELIGIBILITY

- (a) Applicants must be between the ages of 9 and 20 years on January 31st, 2010.  
Birth certificates must be forwarded with this application form (photocopies not accepted),  
and will be at the earliest possible opportunity.*
- (b) Applicants must reside within the county of Louth.  
The applicant's normal home address must be used.  
Use of address of relatives, etc., will result in disqualification.*
- (c) The Local Authority may, at its sole discretion,  
short-list applicants for a music audition.*
- (d) Short-listed candidates will be required to audition in the presence of an adjudicator.*
- (e) The adjudicator's decision will be final and no correspondence on this decision will be entered into.*
- (f) Closing date for receipt of applications is 4.30pm, Friday 26th March, 2010.*
- (g) All applications, irrespective of the address of the applicant within Louth, must be sent to -  
The Arts Office, Dundalk Town Council, Town Hall, Crowe Street, Dundalk, County Louth.*
