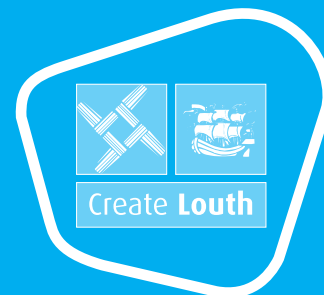


Louth Local Authorities

GUIDELINES

- (d) Closing date for receipt of applications is 4.30pm, Friday 26th March, 2010
