

Louth 2021 Creative Ireland Community Grant Fund

What is the Creative Ireland Programme?

Creative Ireland is the Government's Legacy Programme for Ireland 2016 – a five-year initiative, from 2018 to 2022, which places creativity at the centre of public policy.

What is the Louth Creative Ireland Community Grant Fund?

The Louth Creative Ireland Community Grant Fund will provide support to local and community event organisers in the research, planning and delivery of creative projects that have the capacity to develop into the future.

For this grant fund we are focusing on 2 pillars:

- *Enabling the creative potential of every child*
- *Enabling creativity in every community*

There are two types of grant assistance available:

1. Up to €500 for projects in the research and development phase during 2021 (For proposed delivery in 2022)
2. Up to €5000 for projects that can be completed and delivered by 1st November 2021

Applications must be received by Tuesday 9th February at 4pm 2021.

Criteria

The following must be clearly demonstrated in your application:

- The extent to which the proposed initiative connects with the people, and maximises community engagement
- The extent to which the project proposed is collaborative, unique, innovative, creative and likely to make an impact on the community
- The extent to which the group collaborates with the artist.
- The feasibility of the project, including its likely completion **by the 1st November 2021** if you are applying for the larger amount
- Any additional supports and funding from relevant stakeholders
- Capacity to deliver i.e. Community Organiser(s) must have a clear plan for delivering the project
- Capability to promote the event and provide a potential for media coverage

What amounts are available? Funds allocated will be €500 for development projects and up to €5000 for projects completed in 2021. The fund is limited and eligible applications will be evaluated on a competitive basis. There is no guarantee of funding for events which achieve the minimum eligibility criteria.

Who can apply? This grant scheme is open to groups or organisations that are organising community events, activities or projects in 2021 or developing projects for 2022. To be eligible for funding, the project must be based in County Louth.

What items and expenses are excluded from the fund? Any expenditure on items which was incurred before approval of grant aid was received. Expenditure on fines, penalty payments, legal costs.

How to Apply: All applications by email only.

A signed version of the application may be scanned and emailed (with the appropriate organiser signatures) to creativeirelandlouth@gmail.com. Accompanying additional documentation can be included as appropriate. Please retain a copy of this application for your records.

Applications must be received by Tuesday 9th February at 4pm 2021

If I am successful how do I draw down the Fund? Payment will be made following adjudication and notification of success.

Note: Payment will be made to the community group named on the application form, and not to individuals. Payment will be by Electronic Funds Transfer only. Group bank details must be submitted to facilitate transfer. Successful applicants will receive a Letter of Offer and a contract (between Louth County Council and the Community Group) and will detail all conditions and requirements. A list of successful projects will be published on the Louth County Council website, www.louthcoco.ie.

Acknowledgement Successful applicants must ensure that your project is promoted as part of the Creative Ireland initiative. Appropriate guidelines to support this will be included with the letter of offer.
