Louth County Council invites artists of all disciplines to apply for a Bursary which entitles the successful applicants to a two week residency at the Tyrone Guthrie Centre, Annaghmakerrig, Co. Monaghan. The Bursary will allow the applicant to work towards the completion of a particular project in a unique working environment.

There is no application form for this Bursary. The successful Applicant will have proven conclusively that he or she will benefit considerably from such a residency. He/she will have shown evidence of a significant level of achievement in the relevant field.

To apply, the applicant must submit the following as part of the application:

- (a) A full and up-to-date C.V.
- (b) A signed letter applying for the Bursary, explaining how the award would benefit the work of the applicant, and any other relevant details.

The dates of the residency will be decided in consultation between the successful applicant and The Tyrone Guthrie Centre.

Louth County Council reserve the right not to award a Bursary, if it believes the interests of the County Council, the Bursary and the applicants would be best served by this course of action.
